

POWER RAKE FEATURES



Wheels

- Dual independently adjustable gauge wheels provide the versatility to accomplish several jobs with one machine, increasing productivity
- Allows for skim passes before seeding
- Can adjust to cut drainage grades and other contours
- Wheels fold up and away for easy storage and transport on all models



Tooth Patterns

- The optimized and patented tooth patterns have been designed to create the perfect seedbed for promoting optimal germination and growth conditions
- Maximizes seeding ability with fewer passes, increasing productivity
- The pure carbide proprietary teeth provide long operating life
- The special blunt shape creates the best seedbed sub base that promotes a fracture pattern and superior moisture retention/release capabilities
- Allows efficient windrowing when angled left or right
- Constant down pressure creates a clean seedbed every time



Adjustable Barrier

- Independently adjustable 6" polypropylene barriers allows you to quickly choose the size of material you want to leave on the seedbed. The barrier is stiff enough for pushing yet flexible enough to absorb impacts and keep working
- Allows for versatility in how material is processed/ dispensed
- Lets the operator open up muddy/soggy jobsites quickly



Box End

- Dual position box-end plates allow for windrowing and directing material while operating the prime mover in forward and reverse
- They can be flared out for working along foundations or sidewalks
- Box-ends help contain and direct raked debris like rocks, roots, etc.
- No tools required

Chain Drive Features

- Low profile chain case on the Harley Power Rake minimizes soil disturbance from the case below the plane of the engaged teeth
- The enclosed chain drive with center chain idler has been proven to prolong drive chain life by eliminating chain slap and compensating for chain stretch
- Sprocket ratio delivers torque multiplication, keeping the drum turning in packed or rocky soils
- Chain drive and narrow frame ends allow the drum to work close to the edges of hardscapes

Direct Drive Features

- Dual high-torque bi-directional motors maintain consistent drum speed in forward and reverse
- High quality and durable motors provide high torque and superior performance
- The motor sits tucked behind guards which improves protection and sightlines along the side plate
- Fewer moving parts for reduced service complexity
- The direct drive motor ensures smooth drum operation and eliminates any rattling noise

CHAIN DRIVE MX SERIES POWER RAKES

FOR SKID STEER LOADERS



- Solid tires eliminate flats to maximize uptime and productivity on debris-heavy jobsites
- Bi-directional motor allows the drum to rotate in either direction maximizing flexibility
- Pure carbide teeth design specially shaped to ensure the best possible seedbed sub-base fracture pattern and superior moisture retention and release
- The box-end plates are engineered for quick and easy removal, enabling windrowing and reverse box raking without the need for bolts. Simply pull the pins to detach them
- Dual independently adjustable gauge wheels allow for skim passes for seeding - or - adjust to grade and contour

Simplified Tire Height Adjustment



The tire height adjustment system has been streamlined for ease of use, now allowing changes with a single pin at preset 1-inch intervals. Additionally, tire sizes have been standardized across models ranging from 5 to 8 feet, ensuring compatibility and simplifying maintenance.

Toolless Adjustable Barrier



The barriers adjust tool-free with two quick release pins on each end pin at preset 3/4" intervals, operable by one person.

Fold Up Caster Arms



The caster arms now feature a simplified fold-up design, replacing U-bolts with a single pin for quick release. Operators can fold the arms by pulling just one pin, streamlining the process. Additionally, the caster arm wall thickness has been increased for enhanced durability.

Dual Pin Box End Disconnect




The dual pin box end now uses a single pin for angle changes and two pins for removal, no lifting required. Box end sizes are standardized across 5'–8' models.


FOR COMPACT TOOL CARRIERS

- Adjustable polypropylene barrier above the roller allows you to quickly react to soil moisture conditions. You can choose the size of the material you want to leave in the seedbed. Raising the barrier promotes faster soil drying and opening up of muddy sites.
- Proprietary tooth pattern design. Specially shaped and placed carbide teeth ensure the best possible seedbed sub-base fracture pattern and superior moisture retention and release
- Easily removable box-end plates for windrowing and reverse box raking...no bolts, just pull the pins.
- Dual independently adjustable gauge wheels allow skim passes for over-seeding - or - adjust to cut drainage grades. Simple height adjustment utilizes bail pins for improved reliability.

The Roll Back Barrier's Aperture Control gives the operator 5 separate control options over how the material is handled by the roller and teeth.





Each position change allows the effective surface of the roller to grow. Each position has a different effect on the material being prepared.



APERTURE: THE SPACE BETWEEN THE TOP OF THE ROLLER AND THE BARRIER EDGE —



POSITION 1

Optimal for moving or carrying soils or material. Keeps material moving versus bulding into a large packed pile unable to "breathe and dry".



POSITION 2

The barrier's edge is now directly over the centerline of the roller. Contact area for the roller and teeth is made larger allowing for an increased "grinding" effect on the material.



POSITION 3

The aperture is now larger and the contact area for the roller and teeth is increased even more allowing for more aggressive handling of clumps of material. Reduced particle sizes will slip over the roller.



POSITION 4

More material is allowed to pass over the roller. Less horsepower is required to pull the rake. Travel speed and productivity are increase This position is best used where soils have less rock and debris and are less hard and chunky.



POSITION 5



This position is optimal for opening-up and drying muddy conditions allowing sod to process over the roller, aiding drying of its root mass. This is also great for reconditioning stone roads and parking lots. This is the best position for soil conditioning.
